

Admissions - Bachelor of Engineering [B.E]

A Candidate for admission to the four-year degree course in Engineering must have passed the Intermediate examination of the Board of Intermediate Education, Government of Andhra Pradesh with Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry as optional subjects, or any other 10+2 level examination recognized by the Board of Intermediate as equivalent thereto. All the applicants should have attained a minimum of 45% marks in 10+2 and in case of reserved category 40% marks is required.

The admission to the B.E. course, under "Category A" seats, is through a State-Level Entrance Test called "Engineering, Agricultural Sciences and Medical Common Entrance Test" (EAMCET), conducted by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

- 70% of the seats under "Category A" are filled by the Convener of EAMCET based on the rank secured in EAMCET and as per the rules of reservation in force.
- 30% of the seats under "Category B" are filled by the Management based on the guidelines issued by the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh from time to time.
- Govt. had notified a tuition fee of Rs.1,09,300/- for both "Category A" and "Category B", whereas the College has made a claim for Rs.1,40,000/- per annum from the academic year 2013-14. In Writ Petition No. 21227 of 2013 filed by the College, the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh has made an Interim Order that the liability of each student joining the College shall be subject to further orders in the said Writ Petition.

The candidates joining the College are therefore informed that they will have to pay the difference in the Tuition Fee if so directed in terms of the final orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh in the said Writ Petition.

The Convener of ECET admits candidates at 2nd year of BE (lateral entry), from the stream of Diploma Holders and B.Sc. Graduates with Mathematics as one of the subjects based on the rank secured in Engineering Common Entrance Test (ECET) to an extent of 20% of the sanctioned intake, on supernumerary basis.

- **Fee: As applicable in case of BE (4 Year course).**

Admissions - Master of Engineering [M.E]

An applicant for admission to M.E Course must have the following qualifications:

- B.E./B.Tech. of Osmania University in the ECE or its equivalent for admission into ME-Embedded Systems and VLSI Design & Communication Engineering and Signal Processing disciplines, BE/B.Tech Computer Science Engineering for M.Tech Computer Science and Engineering discipline, BE/B.Tech Electrical and Electronics Engineering for M.E. Power Systems and Power Electronics discipline and BE/B.Tech of Osmania University in Mechanical Engineering/Production Engineering or its equivalent for admission into ME-Advanced Design and Manufacturing. OR AMIE/AMIETE or similar qualifications recognized by O.U. as equivalent to B.E./B.Tech. and candidates must have secured a minimum of 50% marks in the qualifying exam (45% for reserved categories)
- Valid GATE Score obtained in the GATE Examination or rank secured in PGECET.

The admission to the M.E. course, under "Category A" seats, is through GATE Examination or a State-Level Entrance Test called "Post Graduate Engineering Common Entrance Test" (PGECET), conducted by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

- 70% of the seats under "Category A" are filled by the Convener of PGECET based on the rank secured in GATE/ PGECET and as per the rules of reservation in force.
- **Fees for "Category A" & "B" seats: Rs.90,000/- per annum.**
- 30% of the seats under "Category B" shall be open for admission, first to Sponsored Candidates and vacant seats, if any, to the other eligible candidates based on merit, following the guidelines issued by the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh from time to time.

Guidelines for Sponsored Category

- "Sponsored Candidate" means a candidate working in and sponsored (with full pay and allowances for 24 months) by industry/government organizations/private and public enterprises/Engineering colleges recognized by AICTE and possessing two years of professional experience as on the date of receipt of application and also:
- B.E./ B.Tech. degree from a recognized University with 60% aggregate marks in all four years; or
- AMIE and other Associate membership with a valid GATE score/PGECET rank.
- The application shall be duly recommended by the sponsoring agency for admission to the course and forwarded to the Principal, Vasavi College of Engineering, Ibrahimbagh, Hyderabad - 500 031.
- The sponsoring agency shall certify that the candidates will be granted leave for pursuing the M.E. Fulltime course.

Admissions - Master of Computer Applications [M.C.A]

A Candidate for admission to the three-year post graduate course in Master of Computer Applications must have passed the qualifying examination (10+2+3) or equivalent with Mathematics as one of the subjects in 10+2 level and candidates must have secured a minimum of 50% marks in the qualifying exam (45% for reserved categories).

The admission to the MCA course, under "Category A" seats, is through a State-Level Entrance Test called "Integrated Common Entrance Test" (ICET), conducted by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

- 70% of the seats under "Category A" are filled by the Convener of ICET based on the rank secured in ICET and as per the rules of reservation in force.
- 30% of the seats under "Category B" are filled by the Management based on the guidelines issued by the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh from time to time.
- The tuition fee has been fixed at Rs.76,000/- per annum.
