- *** Candidates of 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19 batches, having backlogs in B.E. I&II Semesters and I Year I & II Semesters have to appear in the scheme and syllabus offered in Academic Year 2018-19.

- ii) Last date for submission of examination application forms along with examination fee with a fine of ₹ 1000/- : 12.10.2020 By 6.00 PM
- iii) Last date for submission of examination application forms along with examination fee with a fine of ₹ 2000/- : 14.10.2020 By 6.00 PM

Application forms (submitted through online) will not be accepted after the cut-off dates and timings prescribed.

If examination fee already paid in response to the notification dated: 03.09.2020, need not pay again.

(2 Questions each shall be set from each unit and 11th question from unit – I and 12th question from unit – II


PART-B:
