The students admitted in the academic year 2017-2018, should note that the present academic year 2022-23 is the last chance to complete the backlogs, if any, and become eligible for award of degree in the academic year 2022-2023 and the students admitted in the academic year 2016-2017 are not eligible to appear for these examinations as per the UGC and OU-CBCS regulations Vide. Letter No.336/M/Acad.1/2016 dated 21.03.2016 from Osmania University.
3. The students admitted in the academic years 2013-2014 & 2015-2016, should note that the present academic year 2022-23 is the last chance to complete the backlogs, if any, and become eligible for award of degree in the academic year 2022-2023. The students admitted in the academic year 2014-2015 are not eligible to appear for these examinations
4. The students admitted in the Academic year 2013-2014 completed Eight academic years, hence they have to pay the examination fee on par with the regular students and in addition they are required to pay Rs.2,000/- for each course of registration.
