PART-A:

Total number of questions are *Twelve* and *Nine* questions are to be answered, carrying a total of 18 Marks (9 Q x 2 M = 18 M).

(*Two* Questions from each unit (10 questions) and 11th question from unit – I and 12th question from unit – II).


PART-B:

Total number of questions remains same as *Seven* and only *Three* questions are to be answered carrying a total of 42 marks (3 Q x 14 M = 42 M).

Syllabus:
