**6. Award of Best Theme-Based Projects:**

The members have suggested to introduce awards for the Theme-based projects in order to encourage creativity and implementation among the students. It is resolved to finalize the modalities towards award of the best Theme-based Project to B.E – VI Semester for the 2020-21 admitted students & best projects for B.E – VIII Semester for the 2019-20 admitted students. Further, members have suggested to consider for award of Best – I & II Project Awards on Section-wise basis in place of branch-wise. After thorough discussions, it is resolved to finalize common Rubrics for the evaluation of B.E. Projects duly considering the following aspects:

- Select the Best- I & II projects based on Theme on absolute scale basis keeping minimum cut-off marks separately.
- In any particular theme, if no Project has secured minimum cut-off marks either for Best-I OR Best-II, then that particular award will not be announced.
- Separate award for interdisciplinary projects.

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**7. Mentoring the students for participating in All India Hackathons in the year 2023-24:**

The Principal informed that AICTE has issued the schedule for conduct of Prelims among the students on various themes in connection with the conduct of All India Hackathons in the year 2023-24. Accordingly, the College has conducted Prelims in the month of September, 2023 and identified teams for participation in the finals. In this connection, members suggested to provide mentoring from Industry and R & D experts to the identified teams, so as to perform well in the competitions.

**8. Introducing B.E. (Minor) Degree in Computer Science for the students of Civil, Mech, EEE & ECE admitted w.e.f.2022-2023 academic year onwards:**

Principal informed that the college is proposing to offer a Minor degree in Computer Science and Engineering which is an additional credential a student can acquire if he/she earns 18 extra credits by registering and completing the required courses for the students admitted from the academic year 2022-2023 onwards. On successful accumulation of credits at the end of program. This is mainly aim to the students of Civil, ECE, EEE and Mechanical Engineering disciplines to provide a multidisciplinary approach towards enhancing employment opportunities and pursuing Higher Education in interdisciplinary areas.

Members have suggested to consider to offer a Minor Degree in "Finance Management" for CSE and IT students.
