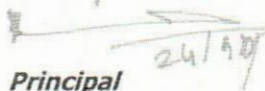

- The term of the Chairperson and members shall be two years. The term of the Special Invitee shall be one year.
 - The Quorum for the meeting, including the Chairperson but excluding the Special Invitee, shall be three.
 - The functioning of Committee will be as enumerated in the Regulations. The committee shall meet as and when required.
 - In considering the grievances before it, the Committee shall follow Principles of Natural Justice. The Committee shall send its report with its recommendations, if any, to the Competent Authority of the Institution with a copy thereof to the aggrieved student preferably within 15 working days from the date of receipt of the complaint. Any student aggrieved by the decision of the SGRC may prefer an appeal to the Ombudsman within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the such decision.
 - All other matters shall be regulated as per the detailed guidelines of the UGC (Redressal of Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2023, dated 11.04.2023 available on the College website www.vce.ac.in
