Loss Dept have organized a Guest lecture on "Information Systems-Types and Uses" by Mr Suryanarayana ,TCS "Hyderabad on Aug 10th 2009. The focus of lecture was to know how Information Systems (IS) refers to the interaction between processes and technology. The Information Systems consists of four parts which include procedures, software, hardware, and information or data, which are essentially the same. There are various types of information systems like transaction processing systems, office systems, decision support systems, knowledge management systems, database management systems, and office information systems. The students of B.E. 2/4 A & B sections actively participated in the Guest lecture.

→ A Guest lecture on "SQL Server" by Mr. Praba Santhana krishnan Microsoft India was organized on Jul 30<sup>th</sup>,2009 for BE 4/4 CSE A&B,IT & MCA. The lecture focused on making data management self organizing and self maintaining with the development of SQL Server. SQL Server can be a data storage backend for different varieties of data like XML, email, time/calendar, file, document and spatial.
