✚ **“Dig Bug - Debug”** contest was conducted for BE 2/4 students on 27th July 2016 under CSI Student Chapter.

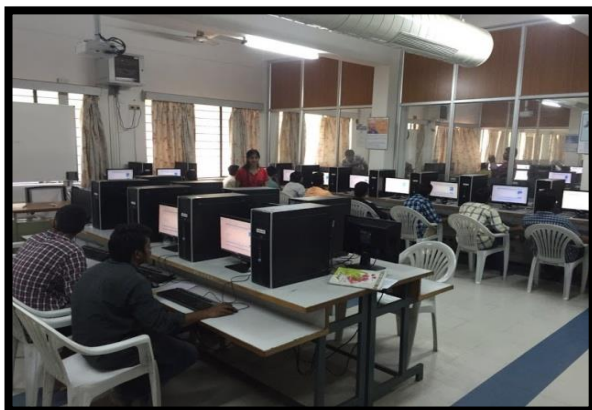

Students were given 30 questions related to technology including basic questions of “C” and were asked to submit the answers within the given time.

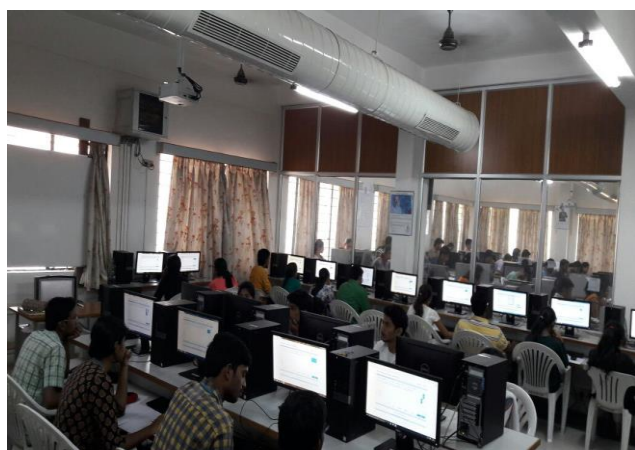
T Abhinav Reddy, K Divya, M Sai Vardhan Reddy, P Chakradhar of CSE 2/4 were the winners.

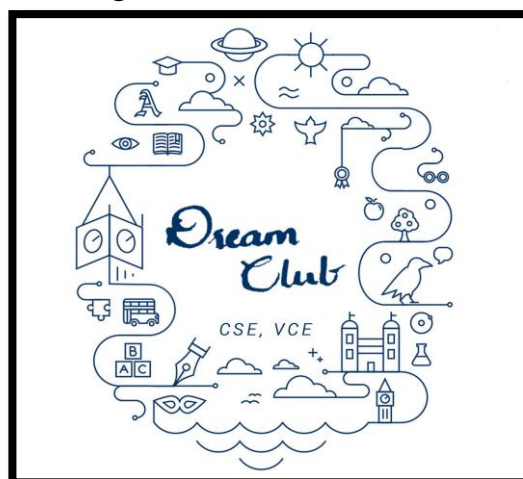
He said about different types of ethical hackers-white hat hacker, black hat hacker, gray hat hacker. He introduced Kali Linux designed for digital forensics.
