1	ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (MATHEMATICS)	<p>Eligibility (A or B):</p> <p>A.</p> <p>i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.</p> <p>ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualification, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D. Degree) Regulations 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time, as the case may be, exempted from NET/SLET/SET:</p> <p><i>Provided</i> the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-</p> <p>a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;</p> <p>b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;</p> <p>c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;</p> <p>d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;</p> <p>e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.</p> <p><i>The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.</i></p> <p>Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET</p>

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (APWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).</p> <p><i>Note: The Academic score as specified in Table 3B shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.</i></p>

Class/Division:

If a class/division is not awarded, minimum of 60% marks in aggregate shall be considered equivalent to first class/division. If a Grade Point System is adopted the CGPA will be converted into equivalent marks as below:
