Eligibility

- 1) Academics – CGPA secured from I Semester to VI semester of BE Program (enclose Xerox copies of Xerox copies of the Grade Sheets).
- 2) Attendance percentage from I Semester to VI semester (enclose printout taken from college website).
- 3) Participation/achievements in Sports/Games (enclose Xerox copies of certificates)
- 4) Participation and/or organizing Technical and Cultural Events (enclose Xerox copies of certificates).
- 5) Guidance, counseling, motivation and assistance to co-students and juniors to create a good learning atmosphere in the college by being a good link between students and teaching community, upholding right values in the campus, discouraging ragging in campus etc.

Interested students from BE- VIII Semester (Final year) may be informed to apply in the prescribed application form (available in the college website) and submit to their HODs **on or before 21.02.2026**. The Guidelines for Evaluation of Applications received for Young Leader Award are enclosed herewith.

HOD, with their evaluation and remarks, shall forward the filled in forms to **Principal by 28.02.2026**.

A selection committee constituted by Principal will finalize the applications and recommend the names of students – one from **each branch by 5.03.2026**.

The names of students selected for award of young leader will be displayed on the notice boards **on 07.03.2026**. The award with cash prize will be given to the winners during College's Annual Day function.

HODs are requested to give wide publicity of this circular to their final year students by arranging to readout in their classes and encourage the students to avail this opportunity **and do not accept any application form without documentary proof (duly signed by the concerned) enclosed.**
